The Maryland State Education Association (MSEA) is organizing a "Keep the Promise" Rally for March 14, 2011. This rally will include locals from all over the state of Maryland. ESPBC and our sister organization TABCO are joining together to make our voices heard.

Busses will be picking riders up from the following five locations. They are;

- Location A - Security Park-n-Ride
- Location B - Franklin High School
- Location C - Cromwell Park-n-Ride
- Location D - White Marsh Park-n-Ride
- Location E - Patapsco High School

Each location will have a bus that leaves at 4:00 pm. if it is 75% full. A second bus will be leaving by 4:45 pm. The march begins at 6:30 pm from Navy Stadium to the State House. Buses are scheduled to depart from Navy Stadium at 8:15 pm.

Please Note: No one under 18 years of age will be permitted to ride unless accompanied by an adult who will be responsible for the child. A box lunch and beverage will be provided each rider.
